The class teacher or whoever's at home should email the poster. The email should include the student's name, school name, school address, and the name of the class teacher

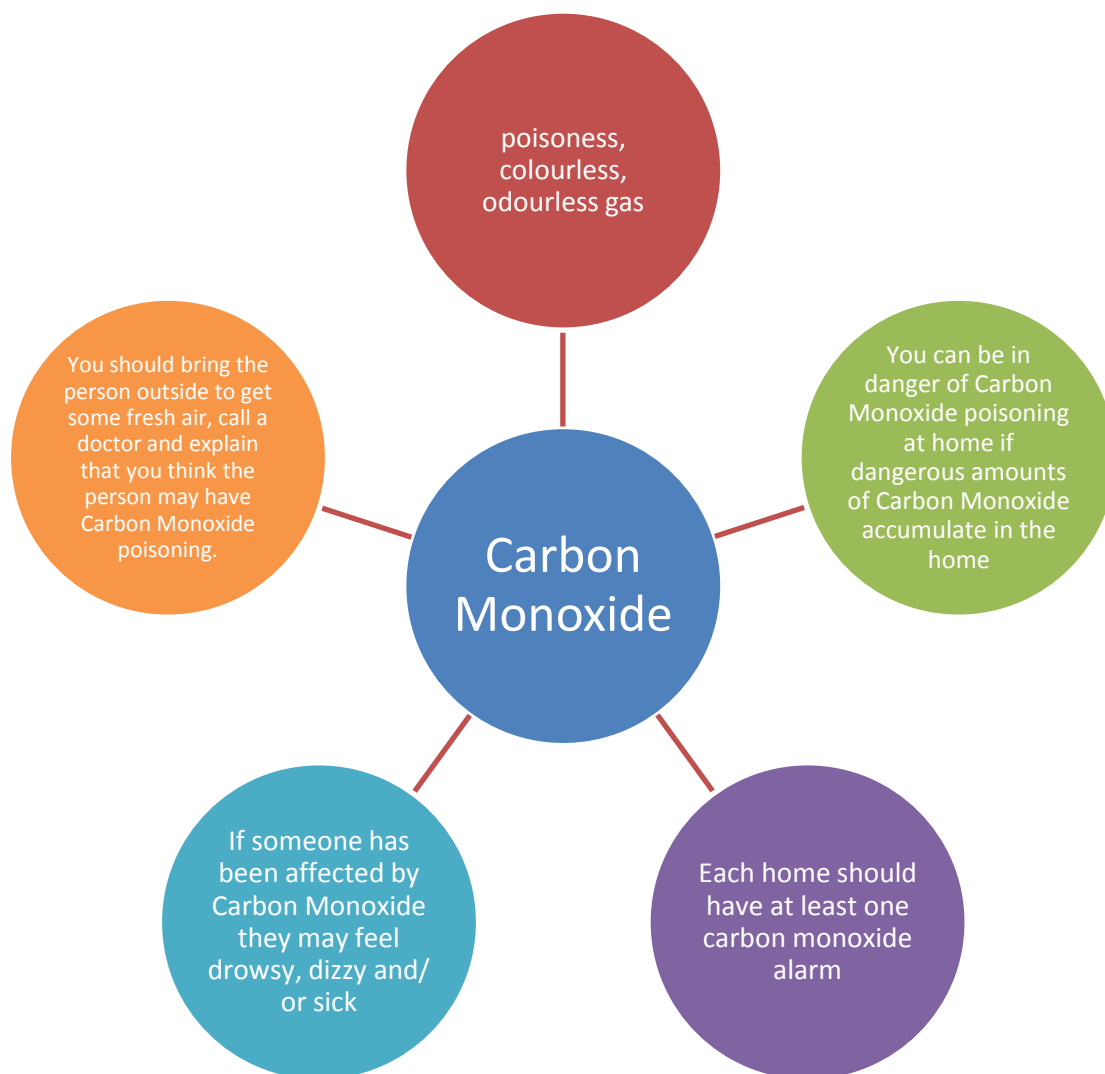
