Option B

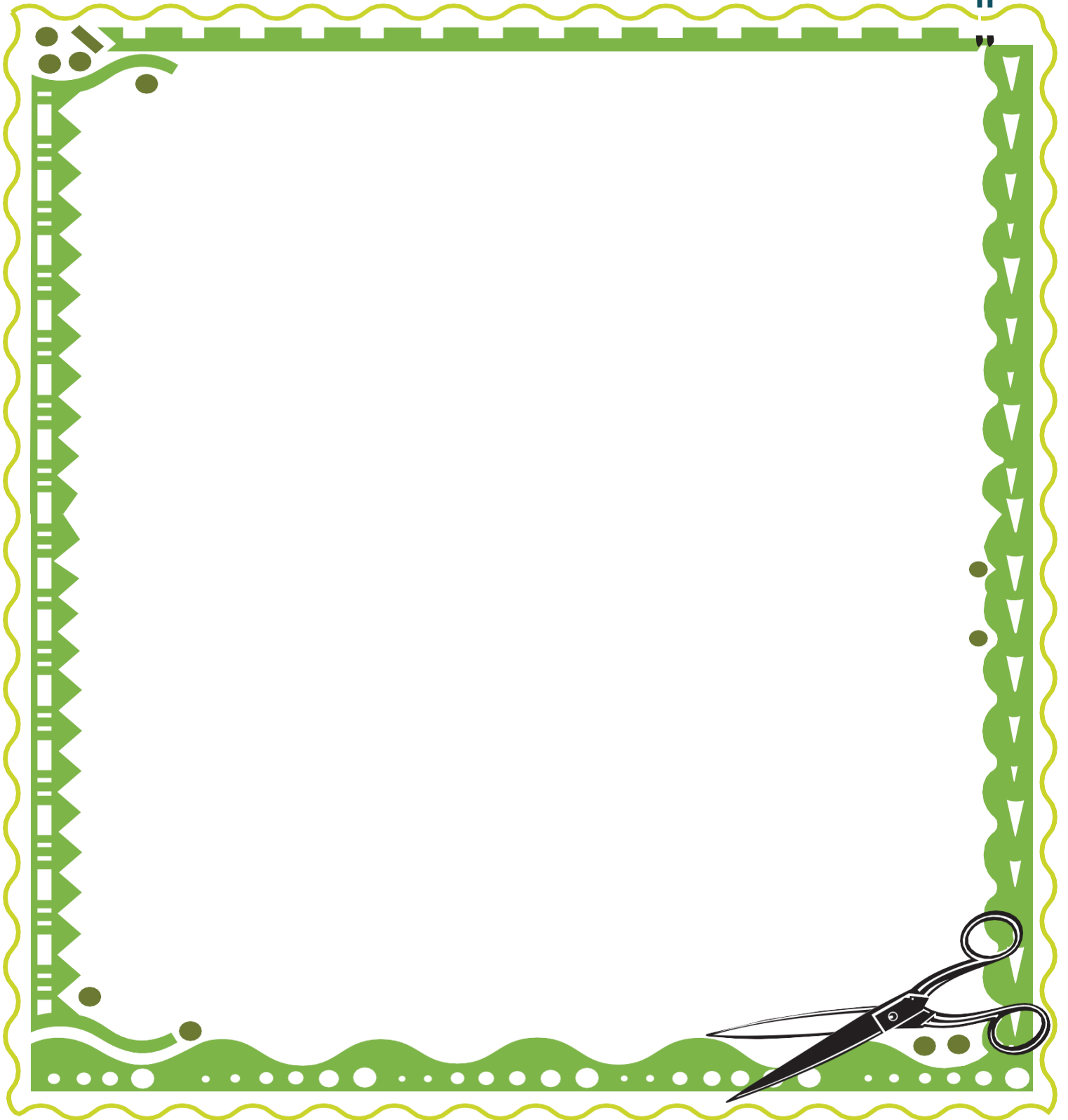
- Create your own business, think of a need or want that is not satisfied in your community and create your own business.

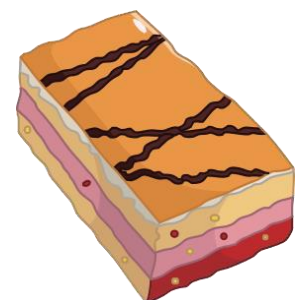
